

Lumholtz's Tree-kangaroo

The only zoo in North Queensland where you can see this endemic tree-dwelling marsupial. Residing in the rainforest canopy makes it elusive and difficult to see in the local region. Wildlife Habitat is a successful breeding centre for the species.

Cassowaries

Learn about the pivotal role the world's third largest bird and local endangered species plays in the preservation of the Daintree Rainforest. Admire these magnificent birds as you wander the Cassowary Walk and through the Rainforest Habitat.

The only breeding pair of Black-necked Storks in captivity!

Be impressed by the sheer size and presence of Australia's only stork species; throughout the year you can observe their breeding and courtship displays: watch as the young hatch, grow and learn to fly.

Croc Feeding

Experience the might of these ancient species. Our Wildlife Keepers will demonstrate the sheer power of the estuarine and freshwater crocodile during an informative feeding presentation in the Savannah Habitat. Ask our Reception staff for daily croc feeding times.



Wetlands Habitat

Follow the Stork Walk to see a multitude of bird species foraging for food in the waterways. The Stork Tower provides visitors with a unique eye-to-eye viewing of our black-necked storks' impressive breeding displays. Within the Stork Tower you will find some of the smaller Billabong inhabitants.

Rainforest Habitat

A meandering walkway allows visitors to experience different levels of the rainforest, from the forest floor to the canopy. Follow the Cassowary Walk to view local species such as the endangered southern cassowary, the Boyd's forest dragon and colourful eclectus parrots and other rainforest species.

Savannah Habitat

On the Wallaby Walk you can interact with and hand-feed kangaroos and wallabies. A host of wild native birdlife use the billabong as a sanctuary. View lagoons where both the estuarine and freshwater crocodiles lurk beneath the water or bask on the sunlit banks.



Woodland Habitat

This habitat offers an opportunity to wander amongst the richly coloured birds of northern Australia's open woodland.

Marvel at the complexity of the locally endangered and endemic finches, watch woodswallows swooping overhead and search for the smallest species that live in the undergrowth, from quail to the endangered northern bettong.

See the creatures of the night come to life! The only nocturnal tour in Port Douglas; in small groups our knowledgeable wildlife keeper will spend 2 hours exploring and spotlighting the parks known and unknown residents with you. On dusk, mix with our kangaroos and wallabies Interact with our amazing nocturnal wildlife such as Mahogany glider, local pythons and Frogmouths Includes feeding of Lesser Sooty Owls and Spotted-tailed Quoll Watch our nocturnal animals wake and begin their
