Board an amphibious World War II *Army Duck* for a unique rainforest tour on land and water, while your driver identifies and introduces fascinating plants and wildlife. Then check out the *Tropical Fruit Orchard*, with over 40 different species of exotic tropical fruits.

Connect with local indigenous culture in the *Pamagirri Aboriginal Experience*. Watch the traditional dance performance in our *Rainforest Amphitheatre* and join the *Dreamtime Walk* to learn about hunting with spears and boomerangs. Enhance your indigenous experience with the *Pamagirri Rainforest Walkabout*, an intimate and interactive look into Indigenous cultures that takes you into the Rainforest.

Featuring wildlife presentations throughout the day, the *Koala and Wildlife Park* gives you the opportunity to hand feed kangaroos and wallabies and see the best of this regions unique wildlife including Lumholtz's Tree Kangaroo, Southern Cassowary, Saltwater Crocodiles, wombats and dingoes to name a few.
