# **COMPANY PROFILE**



The new Cairns ZOOM is the world's first Challenge Ropes Course in a wildlife immersion exhibit, situated in the heart of the city on the roof of the Reef Hotel Casino.

It consists of 65 elements of crossings and ziplines – including one which takes participants directly over the top of Goliath, our 4 metre saltwater crocodile!

Be educated about and interact with native wildlife, and experience adventure at varying heights and difficulty. The course utilises **SafeRoller**, a continuous belay system, with participants connected via a harness to a safety cable system that they are unable to disconnect themselves from whilst traversing through the elements.

# Mid-ZOOM Course

An easier level of difficulty, suitable for initial training and young people, with tunnels, a climbing wall, cargo net, and swings.



## Hi-ZOOM Course

At a greater level of difficulty, consisting of more complex crossings and ziplines for the more adventurous, featuring 3 ziplines — one of which where you dangle over Goliath the croc!

## **PowerJump**

This enthralling component is a freefall adventure, where you jump off a 13m high tower attached by rope to make a rapid descent, with a fan device ensuring a gentle and smooth landing.

#### Dome-Climb

Walk along internal walkways with a unique birds-eye view of inside the Dome, and then an external 60cm wide platform with spectacular views of the city, the Coral Sea, and surrounding landscapes.

### Cairns Wildlife Dome



Parrots, cockatoos and other birds native to the Wet Tropics region fly freely around this rainforest environment. Interact with other animals such as turtles, pythons, freshwater crocodiles, lizards and gliders. In the late afternoon, observe the feeding habits of curlews, bettongs, frogmouths and kookaburras.

Guided tours and presentations are conducted throughout the day, providing fun and interactive learning experiences, on pythons, crocodiles, koalas, mammals and bird feeding.

Meet Goliath the crocodile, and Snowy the white kookaburra, and find out how they found their home on the hotel rooftop. Cuddle a koala and receive a photo as a souvenir, or have your photo taken holding a crocodile, turtle or sugar glider (extra cost).
